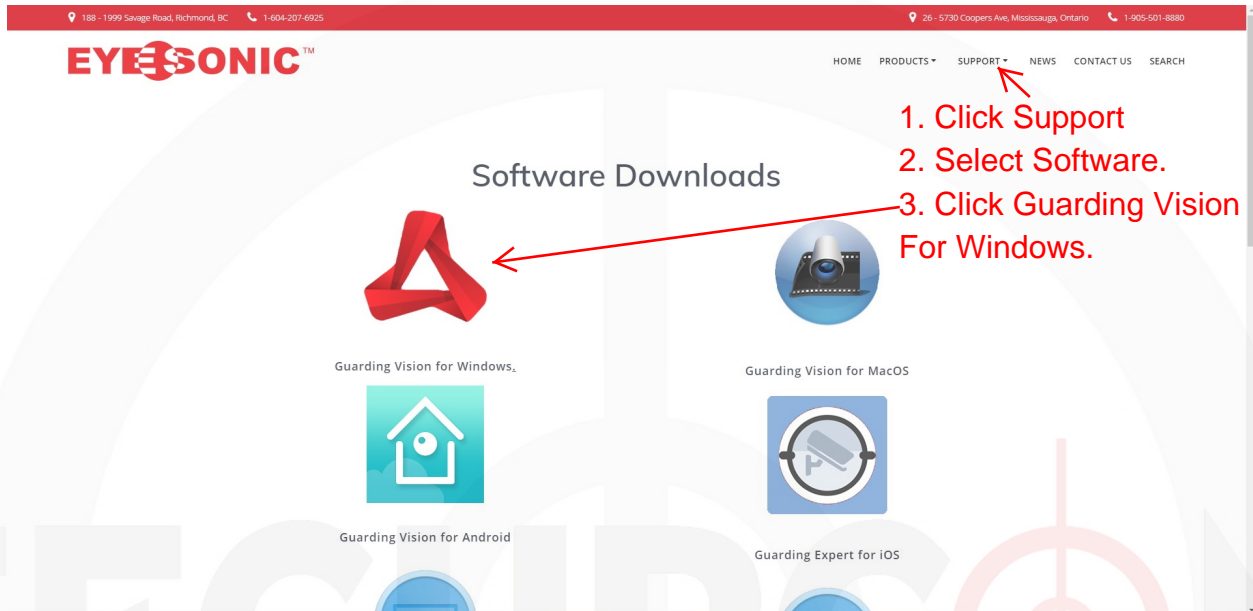

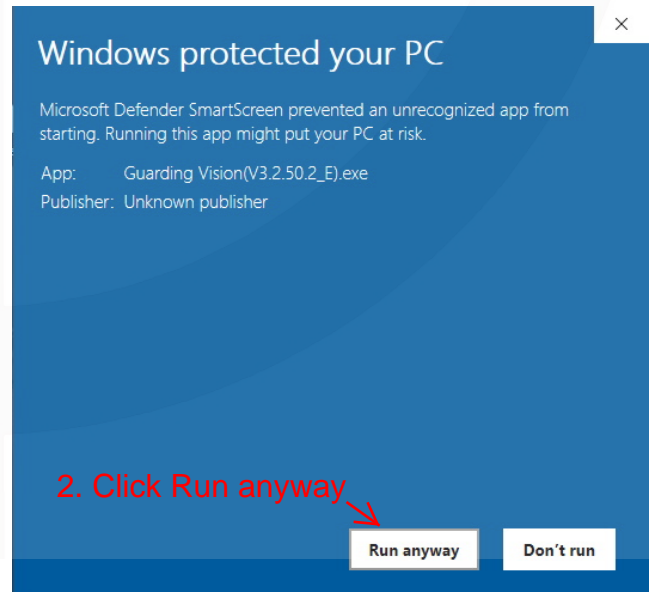


Chapter 1 Installing Software

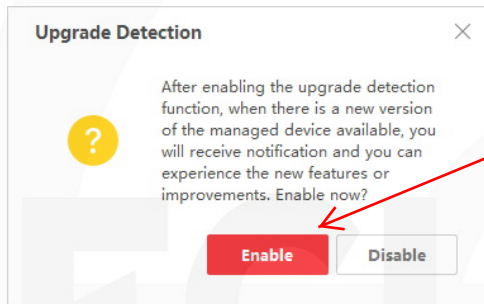
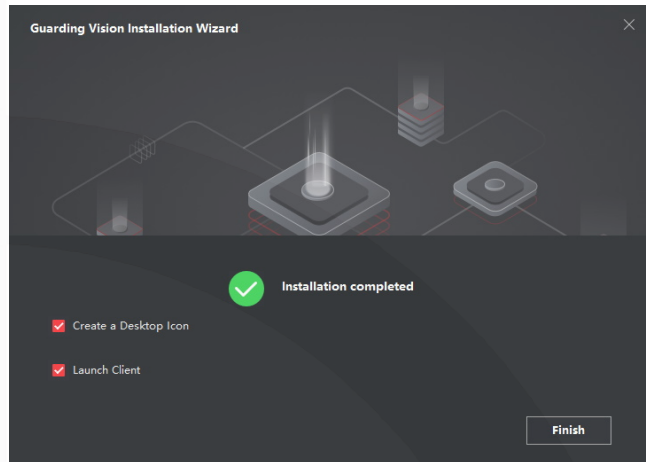
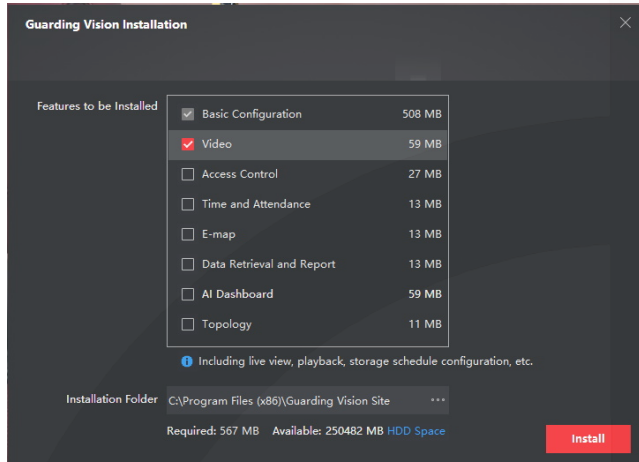
To install the software, first goto www.eyesonic.com, then click support in the top right. Then click on software under the Support option. Click on Gaurding Vision for Windows (Or MacOS if on a Mac) and wait for download to complete.



Next click on the downloaded file, if windows defender prevents the app from starting click on More info, then click on Run Anyway.

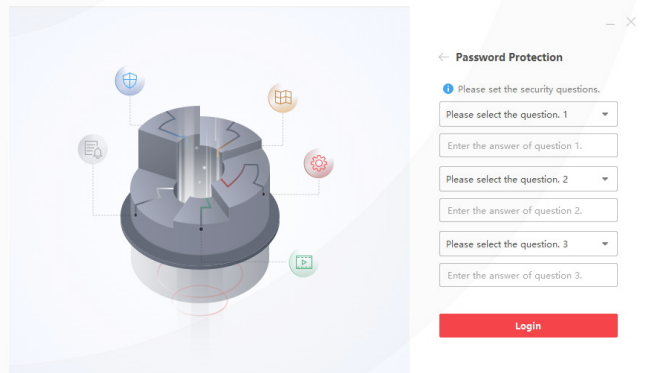
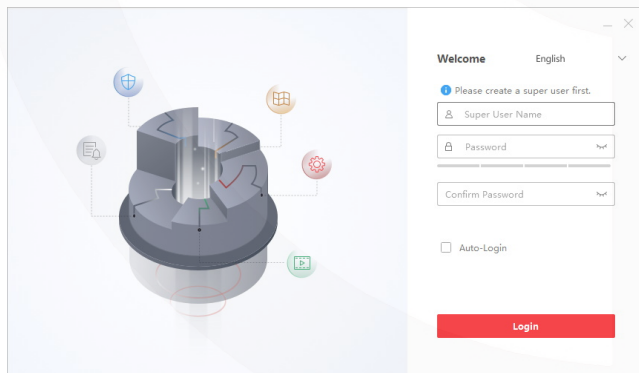


Follow the instructions on from installer, Install Video --> Click Install --> Create Desktop Shortcut --> Click Next --> Click Finish



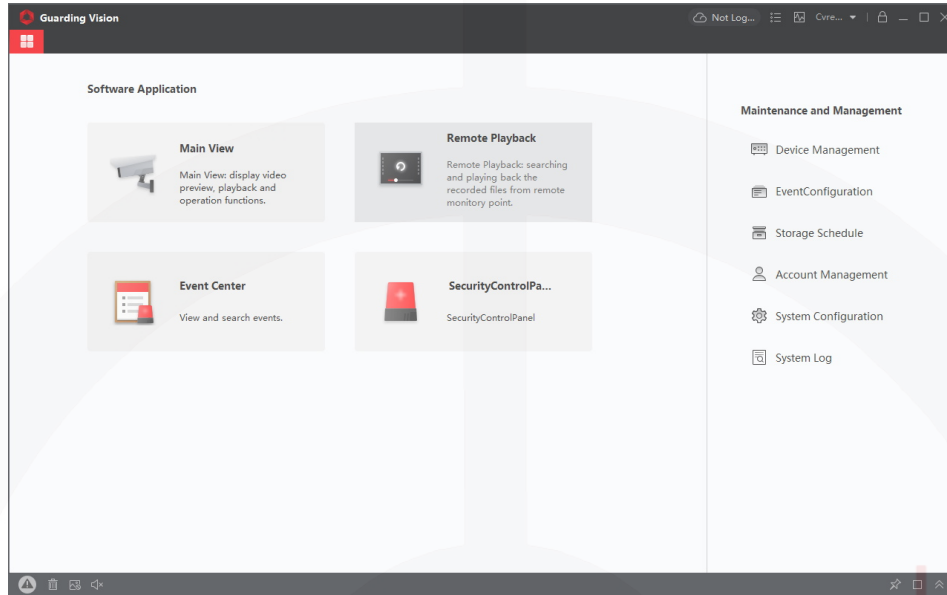
Click Enable on Upgrade Detection to be notified when new versions are available.

Create a super user for app, make sure to write this down as you will need it to open app if auto-login is not checked. Then create 3 security questions.

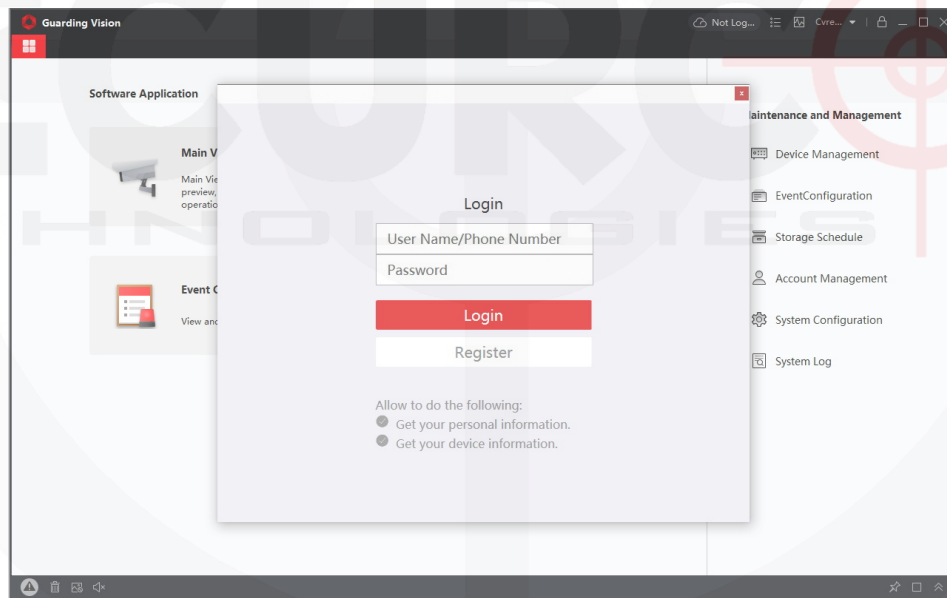


Chapter 2 Cloud P2P Login

In the top right corner of the screen click on the Not Logged In Button.

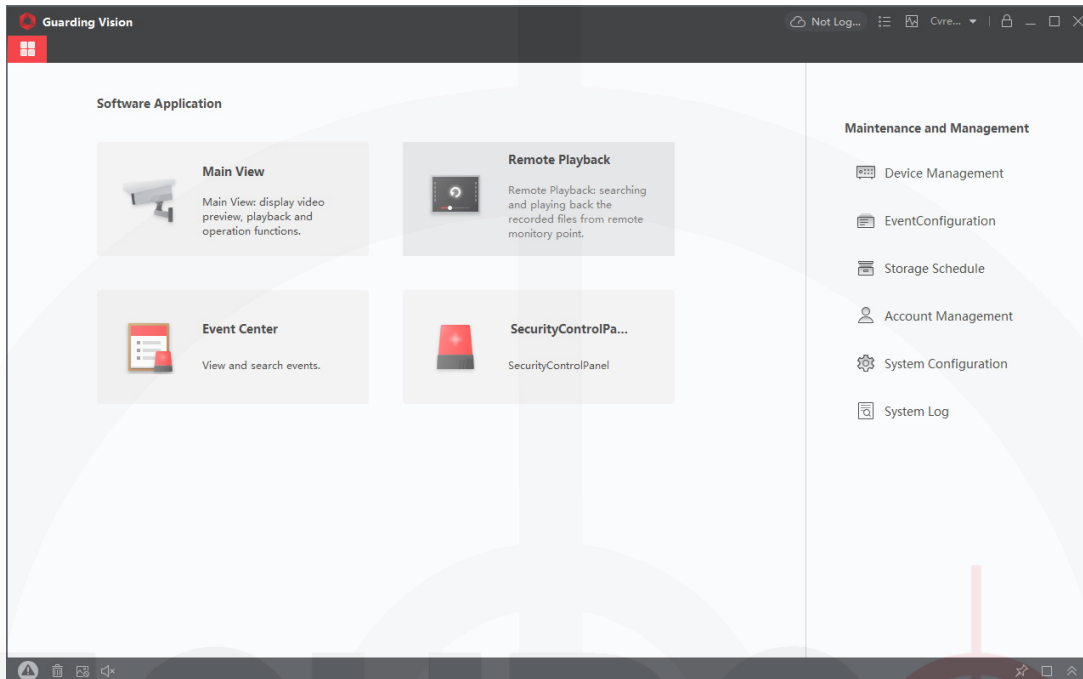


Enter the Email address and password you created or click on Register if you need to create a account.

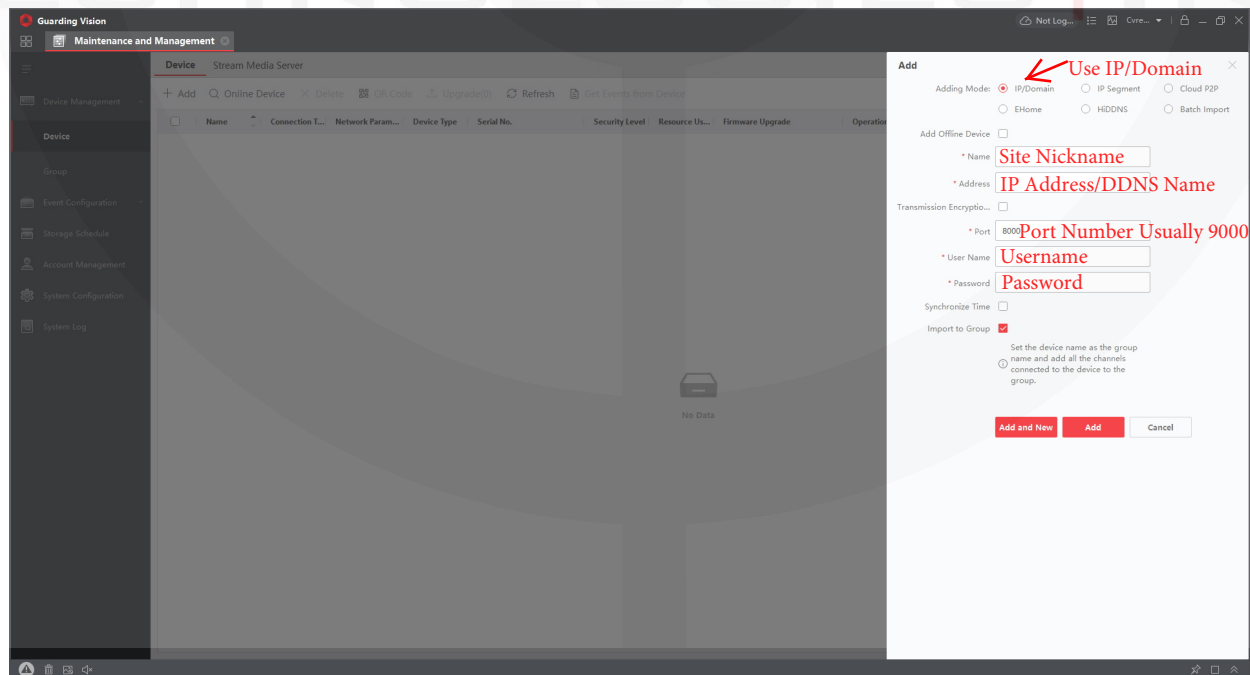


Chapter 3 Adding a Local Device

Click on Device Management on the right hand side of the screen

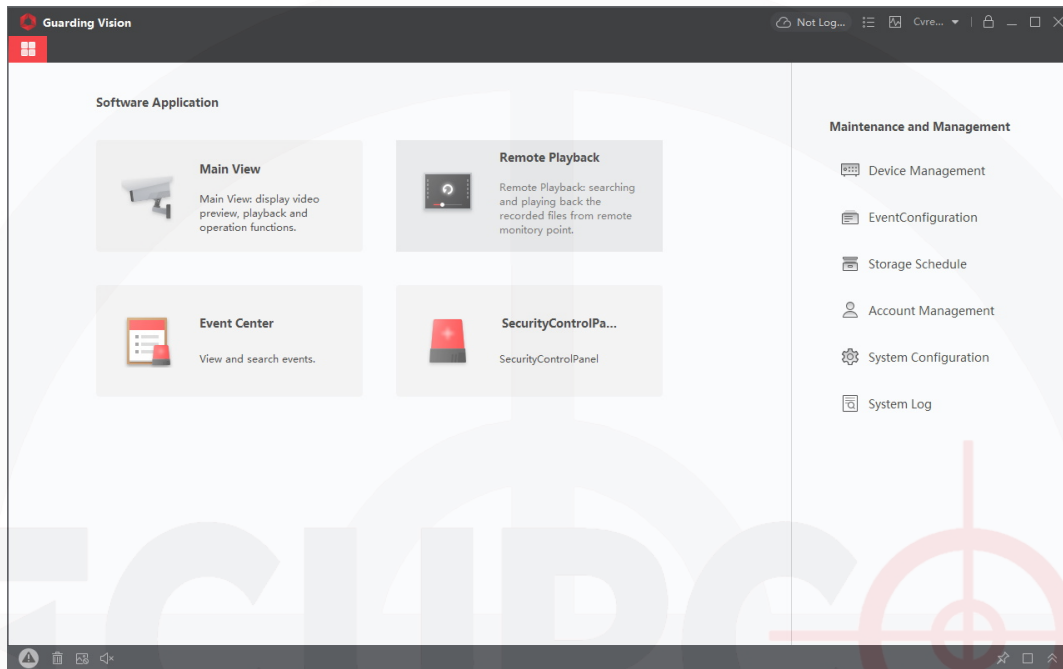


Make Sure that IP/Domain is selected at the top of screen, under nickname enter name of site. For the address enter either the IP Address or DDNS Address (if Setup). Finally Enter port number & User Name/Password Provided. If you need this information contact Securcom.



Chapter 4 Live View

To open software double click on Guarding Vision on the Desktop and if prompted for a login and password enter it, if enable auto login is checked it will not ask you for a login.



Next click on Main View and this will load up your live view screen.
To Load all cameras drag the Site to the main area and it will load up all cameras.

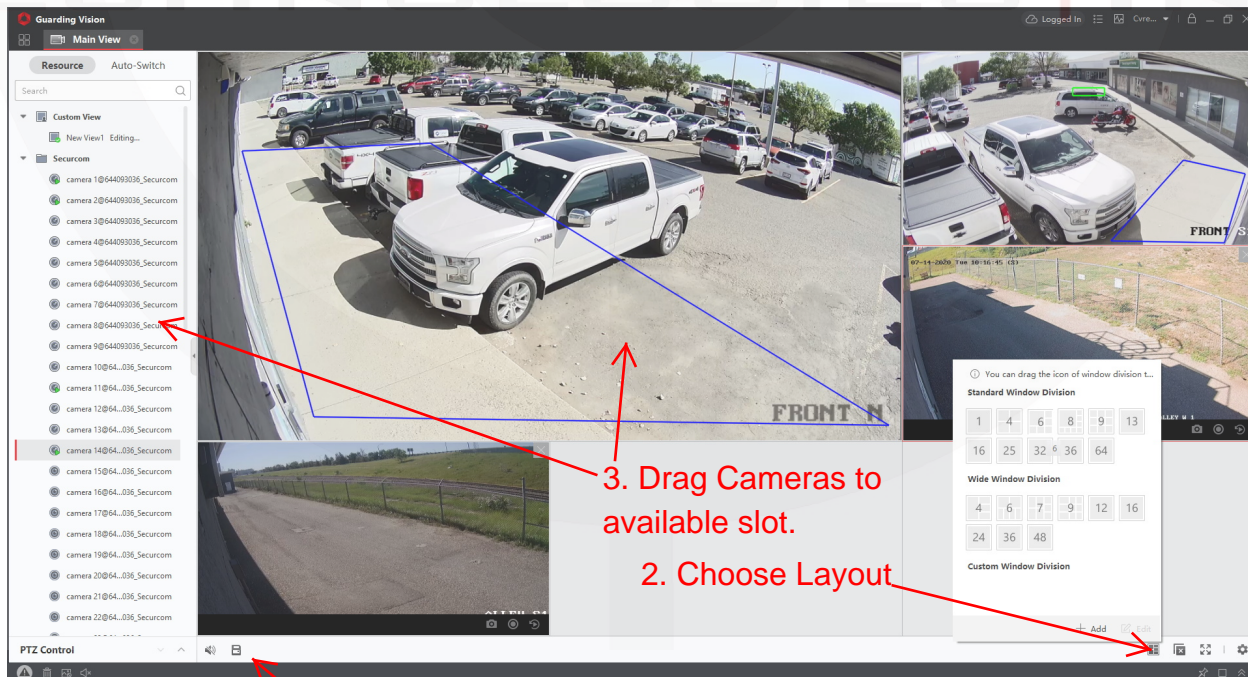


Chapter 5 Custom Views

Custom Views allow for certain cameras to be displayed in a saved layout that you can easily access at anytime and quickly switch between views.



To setup custom views so you can see all cameras at once even from multiple DVRs start by clicking on the + Symbol → Give it a name → Choose a layout → Select Cameras → Click Save.

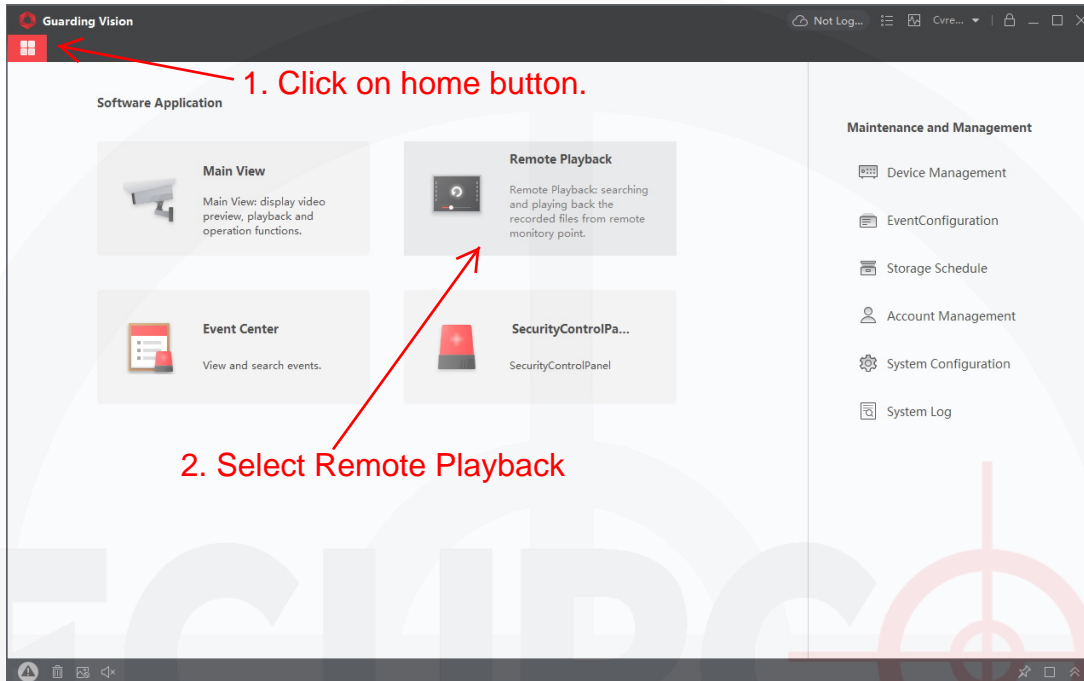


2. Choose Layout

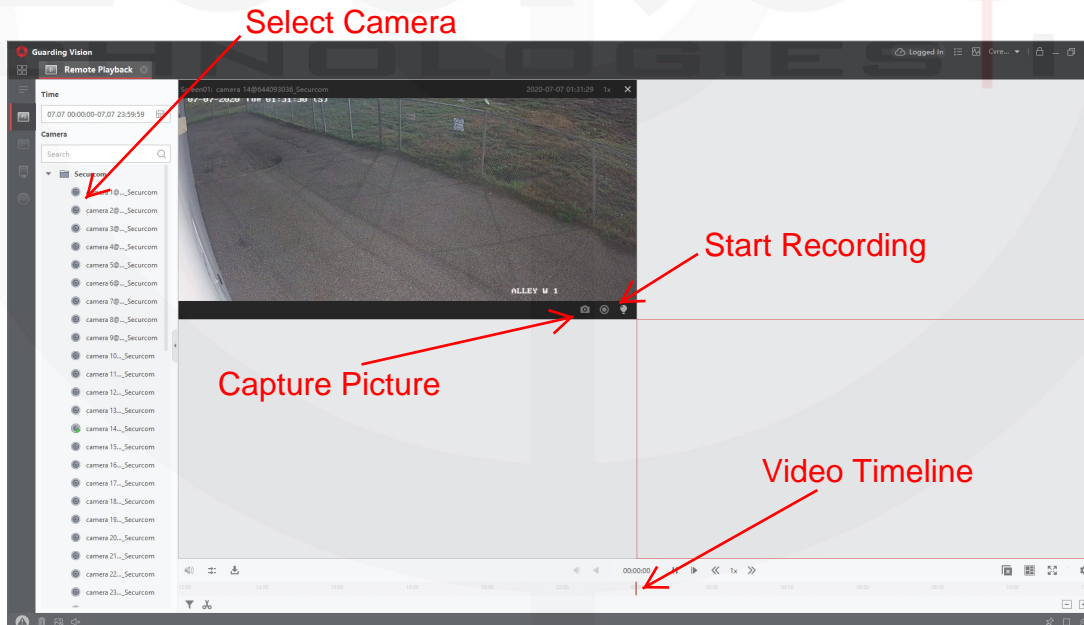
4. Once satisfied with layout click save

Chapter 6 Remote Playback

Remote playback will allow you to access recorded files and play them back .
To access remote playback start from the home screen by clicking on the 4 squares
in the top right of the screen and selecting remote playback.



Select Camera on the right hand side of the screen, at the bottom of the screen drag the
timeline back and forth to the desired time.

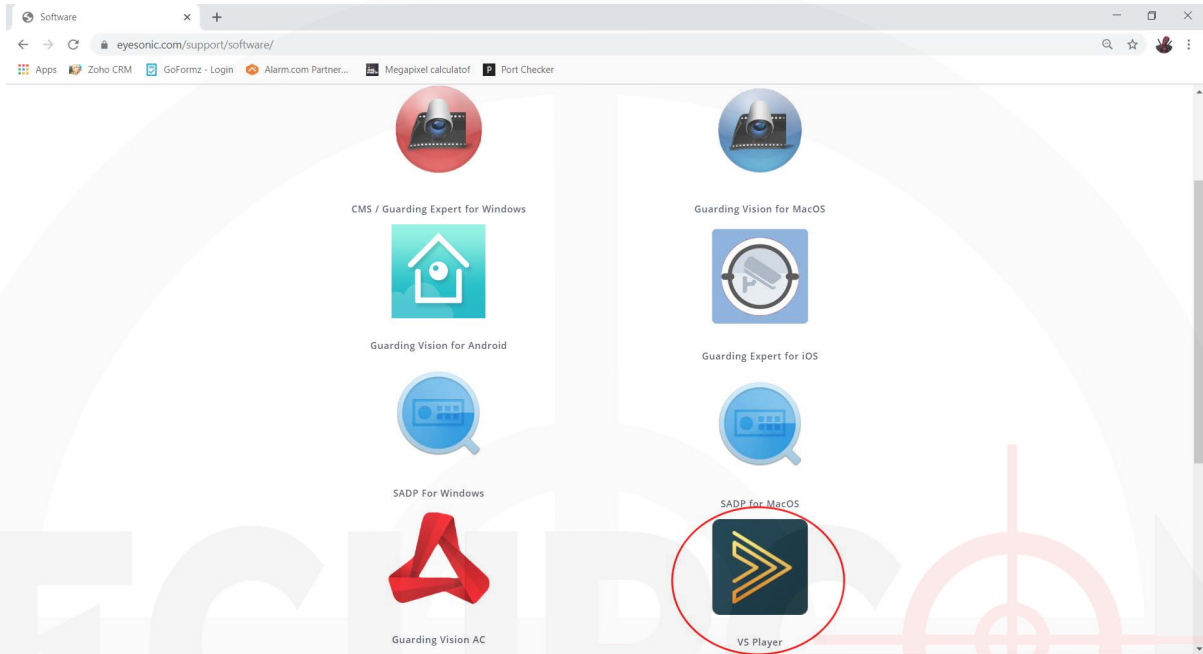


To save a video click on the start recording icon at the start of where you want to record
and again when the event is over. Files will be saved to C:\Users\Public\Guarding Vision
Site\UserData\Video\

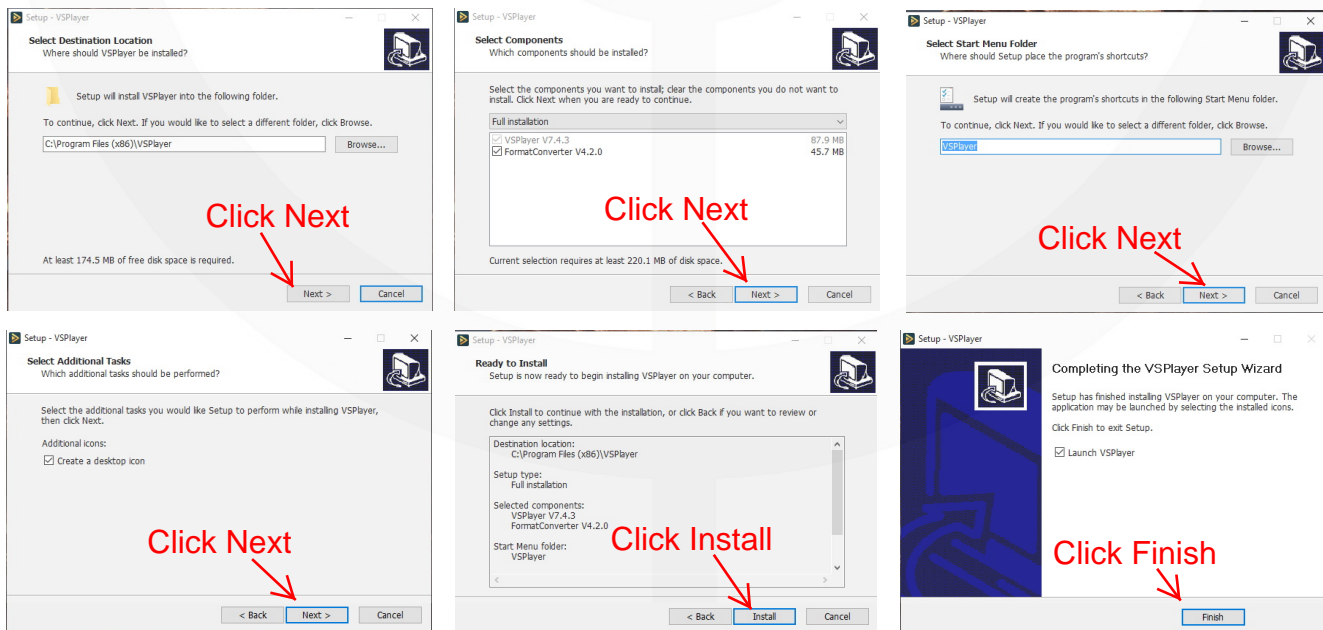
Chapter 7 Dowloading & Setting up Player

To download the player, first goto www.eyesonic.com, then click support in the top right. Then click on software under the Support option. Click on VSPlayer and wait for download to complete.

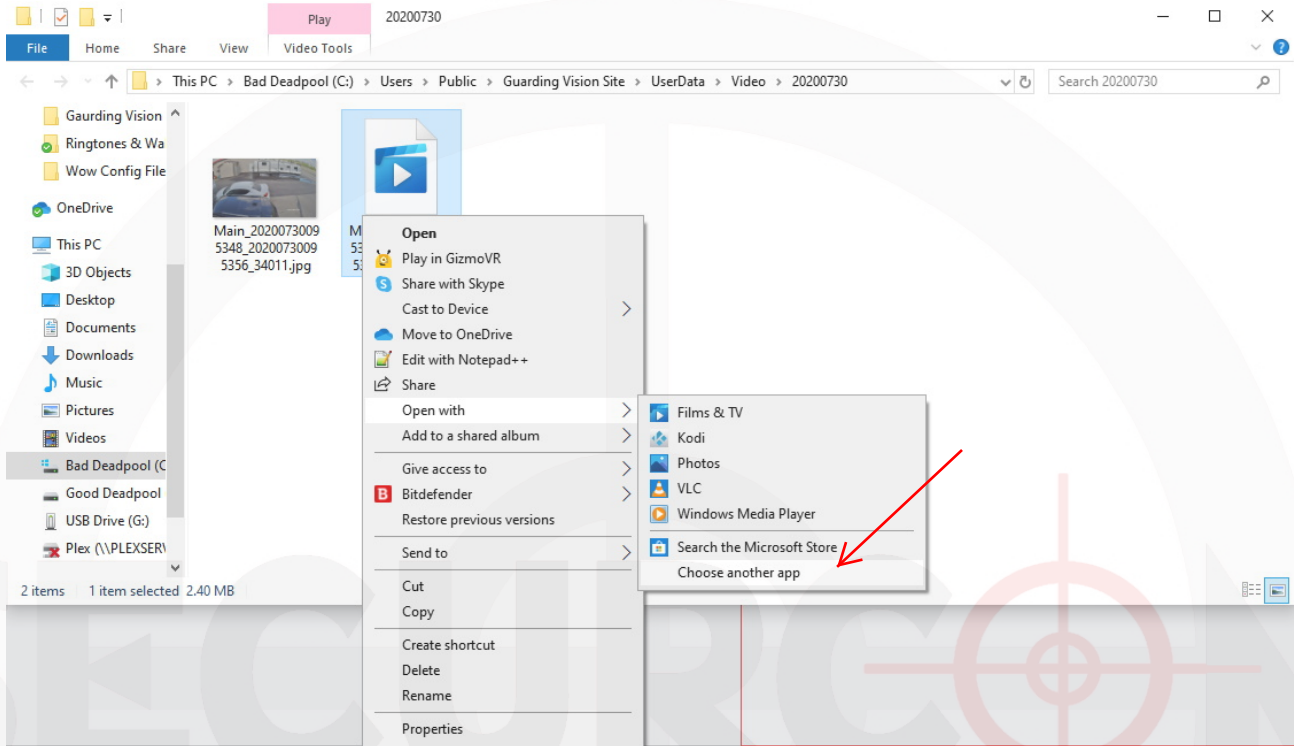


Extract the zip file and run the setup program and follow the install steps below

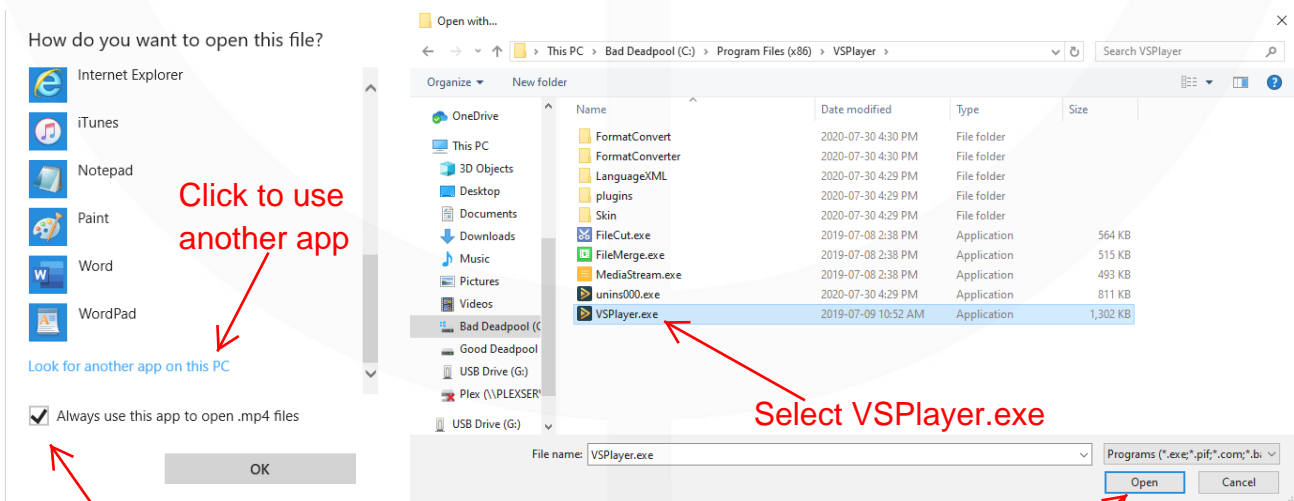


Setting Player to open file automatically

Right click on the video file after exporting it from guarding vision, goto Open with and choose another app



Select Always use this app to open .mp4 files -> Look for another app on this PC. Then browse to the install folder C:\Program Files (x86)\VSPlayer and click Open.
